<b>Diagnostically Focused Evaluation (DFE)</b> Determines the presence/absence of a specific diagnosis, such as ADHD, Autism, OCD, anxiety/mood disorder, or other specific diagnostic condition. Includes administration of panel of measures.	\$1,800.00 (Flat fee) Face-to-face time: 3-4 hrs
<b>Diagnostically Focused Evaluation – Concise (DFE–C)</b> Same as the DFE above but entails limited use of measures and a briefer report. Generally, this service can only be provided to adults.	\$900.00 (Flat fee) Face-to-face time: 3-4 hrs
<b>Diagnostically Focused Evaluation – Brief (DFE–B)</b> Same as the DFE-C above but briefer intake and feedback meeting. Generally, this service can only be done with adults.	\$500.00 (Flat fee) Face-to-face time: 1-2 hrs

<b>Disability Evaluation – Comprehensive</b> Evaluates whether an individual appears to meet psychological criteria for Department of Developmental Disabilities (DDD), Social Security Disability Impairment (SSDI) criteria, or other governmental/legal criteria. Includes a 10-30 page report.	Call to inquire
<b>Forensic Fitness for Duty (FFD) Workplace Evaluation</b> Assesses whether there are any factors or diagnoses significantly impairing functioning, and proposes workplace-related recommendations as necessary.	Call to inquire
<b>Court-Ordered Comprehensive Family Evaluation (CFE), or Focused Assessment (FA), or Independent Psychological Evaluation (IPE)</b> I am court appointed and give an opinion to a court regarding issues including parenting time, parenting fitness, and/or psychological status of members of involved families.	Call to inquire
